

Beiseker, Alberta,
June 15th, 1948

A meeting of the Council of the Village of Beiseker was held in the Beiseker Motor showroom on June 15th, with all councillors present namely F.G. Lamb, Mayor, G. & Schmalz & Leo J. Schmalz

Minutes of the previous meeting were read & adopted. There were no cheques written since the last meeting.

The secretary reported that no appeals on assessments had been received & that tax notices would be sent out forthwith.

The estimate for the year 1948 was presented. All items were discussed & the following By-law was drawn

By-law No 78

" A By-law of the Village of Beiseker authorizing Current Tax Levy for the year 1948

The Council of the Village of Beiseker enacts as follows: Whereas the estimated expenditure of the Village of Beiseker for the year 1948 is \$ 11,156.42 as per estimate in detail recorded and

whereas the total assessed valuation of taxable property within the said Village as shown by the assessment roll is \$ 173,736.00

whereas it is estimated that the sum of \$ 272.00 will be collected from sources other than current levy, thus leaving the amount to be collected from current taxes 10 884.42 to which is to be added for non-collection 585.46 making the total current taxes to be levied 11 469.88

Therefore the mill rate shall be for
School Tax 40 mills -
Municipal Tax 26 mills -
making the combined rate 66 mills - "

The above By-law received three readings and was unanimously passed.

It was decided that a discount of 5% shall be allowed on current taxes paid on or before July 19th. A By-law as follows was drawn accordingly

By-law No 79

" A By-law of the Village of Beiseker providing for the (pre-payment of taxes)

The Council of the Village of Beiseker enacts as follows That a discount of five (5%) per cent shall be allowed on all current taxes paid on or before July 19th, 1948.

The above By-law received three readings & was unanimously passed.

The By-law re licenses for dogs was to be discussed at a later date. Moved that the meeting adjourn
