A special meeting of the Council was held in the Mayor's office on Saturday morning, March 11th commencing at 10:00 A.M. In attendance was Louis H. Schmalz and Leo Scheffman.

As the minutes from the previous meeting had not been written up, the Secy-Treasurer was to read them at the next meeting.

Mr. Leo Scheffman was not in attendance and upon checking with the local Post office, it was found out that the registered letter had not been picked up by Mr. Scheffman. This made a latter meeting with Mr. Scheffman necessary. No definite date was set.

A check was made to find out whether the titles to our present school grounds were in our custody. It was discovered that the titles to Block "S", lots 6 to 11 in Block 11 and lot 12 in Block 11 were picked up by Mr. J. H. Schmalz on March 9th, 1933 and signed for by Mr. J. H. Schmalz in a book held in the office of Mr. J. Q. Hunt. The Mayor phoned Mr. J. H. Schmalz at his home regarding this, and Mr. J. H. Schmalz promised to check with the office at Strathmore as to the whereabouts of these titles, also, as in whose name these titles were registered. These titles were registered in the name of the Berried Consolidated School District when Mr. J. H. Schmalz picked them up.

In dealing further with the school question, and the fact that the Westland School Division proposed to build a new school in our present baseball park, a new park had to be secured by the Village. It was suggested that perhaps the Village could secure the property immediately east of the present baseball park. This property consisted of approximately 23 acres and was owned by the Estate of Andrew Schmalz of which J. H. Schmalz was the Executor. The Secy-Treasurer was instructed to write a letter to Mr. J. H. Schmalz, the executor, requesting him to study the possible sale of this property to the Village.

Business was discussed. The Secy-Treasurer was instructed to get additional information. The new assessment was tabled until a latter meeting.

Moved by Mr. Schmalz that the meeting be now adjourned 12:15 Council.
