Mayor H. Long, Chairman for the meeting, opened by asking Mrs. Byres to suggest an order of business due to the fact that she had graduated from the Old's Civil Defence School for Instructors.

Mrs. Byers advised the meeting to appoint a Controller or Controllers to supervise the organization. Mayor L.L.Schmaltz of Beiseker moved that Mrs. Eline Byees be appointed Chief-Controller for Beiseker and Irricana and that a Deputy*Controller be appointed in each of the above Villages by the respective Councils. The motion was seconded by Mr. J.Steele. CARRIED

The respective councils then took up the problem of appointing Deputy-Controllers. The Village of Irricana appointed Mr. Bell, Secretary-Treasurer of the said Village, to represent them. The Village of Beiseker appointed Mr. L.W.Bunyan, Secretary-Treasurer of the said village, to represent them.

It was then agreed that the above appointments shall be called the Control-Committee.

After some discussion the Meeting agreed that the Controller should give a course on controlling to persons from each of the Villages. The number of persons from each Village is to be SIX if possible and functional if possible. (e.g. Fire--- The Fire-Chiefs)

The Secretary for the meeting was advised to inform the authorities of these appointments.
