From the Dept. of Public Welfare requesting a current report on the status of Mrs. Lavina Ross. The Sec-Treas. was instructed to have the Public Health officer Mrs, Wald obtain the necessary information and to send in the report to the Dept as requested.

From the Village assessor Mr. Bockman giving his recomendations with regard to the assessment of the property of Parrish & Heimbecker Ltd. The Council agreed to abide by these recomendations in making their decision as the Court of Revision on the aforementioned assessment.

The subject of the culverts on the approaches to the elevators on the C.P.R. side of the Village was brought up for discussion. The Council agreed that an examination first hand of the situation would have to be made. It was agreed to meet on Tuesday evening, August I4th for this purpose.

The Sec-Treas. brought up the question of frontage on the property of Mrs. L. Fisher. It was pointed out that Mrs. Fisher had been assessed for 66 ft. of frontage that was now owned by the Village as a result of the completion of the new subdivision in that area. Councillor Lavoie moved that the frontage tax for these 66 ft. be cancelled for the year 1956 and thereafter.

## CARRIED

Mayor Schmaltz reported that the Sewer Lift station had been pumped out by Dunkley Bros. Ltd. of Calgary at a fee of \$ 200:00. In this connection the Sec-Treas. turned over to the Council a contract left by the contractors for the study of the Council. The contract provided that the contactors would pump the lift station once a year for six years at a fee of 75:00 per year. After some discussion the Sec-Treas. was instructed to write the contractors requesting the addition in the contract of a"termination for cause by either party" rider.

The Council studied the briefs from Mr. J.H. Schmaltz and from the Estate of Andrew Schmaltz regarding the claims of the said parties in connection, with the sewage disposal site. The Sec-Treas. was instructed to write to Mr. E.C. Collier, the village solicitor asking if he had received a copy of the brief: and also asking for the present state of affairs in the matter.

Building

The following building permit applications were presented to Permits; the Council for their consideration;

Councillor Lavoie moved that these applications be approved CARRIED

Mayor Schmaltz stated that the Beiseker Hotel would require an extra sewer service for the addition to the hotel. He asked the Council to decide which party would stand the cost of this service. After some discussion. the Council agreed that the Village would lay the extra sewer service at the expense of the Village.

The Council discussed the hiring of a contractor to dig approximately 270 ft. of ditch for sewer & water services. Councillor Velker agreed to contact Mr. Otto Tetz regarding this work.

The No. 2 well was next discussed by the Council. It was felt that a pump house should be built over the well in the nea: future. The Council agreed to contact Mr. Alex Metzger with a view to having him assist Town Foreman Jack Krenzler in the construction of this pump house.
