It was moved by Councillor Schmaltz that the Council have the third reading of By-Law # 74-4 at this time. Seconded by Mayor Schmaltz. CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

It was therefore moved by Councillor Schmaltz to read the third reading of By-Law # 74-4 setting the Mill Rate for the Village of Beiseker for 1974 at 80 Mills. Seconded by Mayor Schmaltz. And finally passed. CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

BUILDING PERMITS:

A building permit was received from Milton Martin to build a garage on Lot 8, Block 1, Plan 2950 I.B. Mr. Martin asking Council for special permission to build this garage 3 feet from the property line instead of the regulation 5 feet from the property line.

This was discussed by Council at some length and moved Councillor Schmaltz to pass this building permit with the stipulation to Mr. Martin that he must stay 3 feet from the property line. Seconded by Mayor Schmaltz. CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY

A building permit received from Mr. G. Williams to building a home on Block 3, Plan 1376 J.K.

It was moved by Councillor Schmaltz to pass this permit Seconded by Mayor Schmaltz CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

There being no further business Mayor Schmaltz adjourned the meeting.

The public hearing must be held not less than ten days after the second publishment. Mr. Longpre than excused himself from the meeting.

The service line to the new arena was discussed at some length by council and was decided on a motion by Mayor Schmaltz that the Village install the new line into the arena with a hydrant beside the building. CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.
