MINUTES:

Minutes of the previous meeting were circulated to Council prior to the meeting and moved by Councillor Martin adopted as circulated, with the correction being made to the minutes to read that the salary of Mr. Anderson, town foreman to be reviewed after 90 days. CARRIED.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT:

The Financial Statement was not read as the Secretary is bringing the financial statement corrections up to date with the Auditor. To be presented to Council when this is completed.

REPORT FROM TOWN FOREMAN: Mr. Anderson attended the meeting to discuss with the any problems that he may have encountered since starting the new position. Council and Mr. Andersson discussed all aspects of the job and suggested that perhaps some letters should be sent to a few residents re garbage stands etc. After a good discussion, Mr. Anderson excused himself from the meeting.

MUSICALES DOROCT

Councillor Martin reported to Council that there had been complaints about the snowmobiles within the Village limits and that he had the Secretary send a copy of the Snow-mobile By-Law to the Five Village Weekly to be published to remind the local residents of the rules and regulations and this was than discussed by Council and Secretary to mail Corporal Olsen of the R.C.M.P. detachment a copy of the By-Law.

Councillor Whitnack reported to Council that a Seismic Crew would be doing some work within our area and had asked if they would be able to get water from the Village for their rig, this was discussed prior to the meeting with Council and decided that they would have to charge them 2¢ per gallon. Councillor Whitnack to give them the Council's decision.

The water to the Arena was discussed by Council and at this time the Village has never charged the Arena Society for the Water and Sewer to the Arena. Mayor Schmaltz suggested that perhaps a meter should be installed at the Arena so that they would be made aware of the amount of water that is being used. All agreed that this should be discussed with the Arena Board and that a meter should be installed.

The installing of water meters in some of the mobile homes in the Village and also some homes that do not have meters was discussed by Council and Councillor Whitnack to check with Heaton's Plumbing of Acme to see if he could do this work for the Village.

Councillor Whitnack also gave the Council a report on the Regional Resources Project #1 and the projects that they were involved in.

Councillor Martin reported that he had attended the meeting at the Lodge at Crossfield and that A. L. Patterson was the Chairman. And also gave a report on the new lodge at Cochrane. Councillor Martin also stated that all the applications for grants under the Recreation Board were applied for and the Village would be eligible for approximately \$2900.00 for operation grants.

Mayor Schmaltz than showed Council the Aerial pictures and study down by the Calgary Regional Planning Commission. This is a study for future growth and feasibility study of the Village. This was discussed and studied at some length by the Council.
