THE MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL MEETING OF THE RATEPAYERS OF THE

VILLAGE OF BEISEKER, HELD ON THURSDAY THE THIRTEENTH DAY OF

FEBRUARY, A.D. 1958, IN THE MEETING ROOM OF THE MEMORIAL HALL.

Chairman:

Mayor Schmaltz opened the meeting and called for nomination: for a chairman for the meeting.

Mr. K.A. Wright was nominated by Mr. Matt. Schmaltz.

There were no further nominations, and Mr. Wright was declared elected by as Chairman of the meeting by aclamation.

Mr. Wright took the chair and appointed Mr. D.W. Smith as Secretary for the meeting.

Minutes:

The Secreatry read the minutes of the annual meeting of the ratepayers held on the eleventh day of February, 1957.

Mr. Matt. Schmaltz moved that the minutes be adopted as read Seconded by Mr. J.H. Schmaltz and Carried.

Mayors report:

Chairman Wright called on Mayor L.L.Schmaltz for his report. In his report, the Mayor stated that public works projects had been curtailed somewhat due to lack of finances but that some sidewalks had been built with the Village buying the cement and gravel and other interested organizations supplying the labour. On the matter of the trailer court built recentely in the Village, the Mayor stated that the Council felt it would be a good investment in the future and would utilize otherwise wasted land. Reporting on the Nuisance ground, the Mayor reported that this property was now fenced and was kept locked at all times and also that a trenchingsystem was being used for the disposal of waste material. On the question of natural gas, the Mayor stated that the Council was very interested in the matter but that there seemed little could be done at present except wait for developements. In closing, the Mayor stated that he felt the Council had had very good co-operation from the ratepayers during the past year.

Mr. Matt. Schmaltz asked How many services the water and sewage system had at present and the reply given was IOI.

Councillors report:

councillor Velker, in his report, called on the businessmen of the Village, for their continued support in the furtherance of the Village's interests.

Councillor Lavoie stated that he found the work of the G Council interesting and that he hoped he could be of further service to the Village in the future.

Financial State.

Chairman Wright called on the Secretary for the reading of the financial statement of the Village for the year ending Dec. 3I, 1957. Following a lengthy discussion of the report, Mr. Matt. Schmaltz moved that the report be accepted. Seconded by Mr. Carl Lohrke and <u>CARRIED</u>.

Inspectors report:

of the Chairman next called on the Secretary for the reading of the Municipal Inspector's report for the Village for 1957. The Secretary statted that all points mentioned in the report had been acted on by himself and the Council.

Public Works:

Public Works superintendent, Mr Matt. Schmaltz, stated that he had not much to report on regarding his department but on the matter of natural gas, he suggested that the Council might make formal application to the Gas Co. for gas service.

Further to this subject, Mr. J.H. Schmaltz, stated that to his knowledge, there was no possibility of obtaining gas sevice in 1958.
