Dave Dell, President of the Beiseker & District Chamber of Commerce will also be in attendance at this meeting.

Cemetery

Councillor Hnybida advised Council that the Cemetery Society has not received any response for their request for funding towards the cemetery sign from the Beiseker Lion's Club, Beiseker & District Chamber of Commerce or the Beiseker Ag Society. Council suggested that the cemetery society may also wish to approach the Beiseker Senior's Club for funding.

Deputy Mayor Courtman advised Council that it has been brought to his attention that the Fire Department is being faced with a shortage of members on the department, with the most critical shortage occurring during the daytime hours.

Airport

Deputy Mayor Courtman advised Council that the adjacent landowner that has been charged with trespassing on the airport will be returning to Court on July 7, 2004.

Recycling

Deputy Mayor Courtman advised Council that Beiseker Recycling now has a trailer strictly dedicated for glass for hauling to Airdrie. The little money that is received from the recycling of the glass at least covers the transportation costs.

Rowe

Library Board

Councillor Rowe advised Council that the meeting with the Marigold Library System that was scheduled for May 8, 2004 had to be cancelled.

Tourist Booth

Councillor Rowe advised Council that Brian & Reese Graefer have been busy working on the interior of the tourist booth and have dedicated a lot of volunteer hours in that regard. Brian is going to build the countertops and magazine racks for the inside of the tourist booth. More signage will be needed to advertise the tourist booth.

Intensive Livestock Operations

Councillor Rowe advised Council that he attended a meeting hosted by the M.D. of Rockyview in Irricana on April 29, 2004 regarding changes to the regulations surrounding the location of intensive livestock operations. Unfortunately, the meeting was not particularly informative.

Councillor Priestman advised Council that he attended a meeting of the Rockyview Foundation on May 5, 2004. It was noted that the Foundation's 2004 requisition to the Village of Beiseker was down from 2003.

Councillor Priestman further advised Council that the Foundation is currently in the process of gathering quotes from mechanical contractors for annual maintenance contracts.

Councillor Priestman advised Council that the next meeting of the FCSS/Recreation Board is scheduled for May 18, 2004.



#### **Fegan**

Concrete at the Transfer Station

Mayor Fegan advised Council that Vaughan Uffelman would like to use some of the concrete presently stockpiled at the transfer station to create a fish pond on his property. Council agreed that Mr. Uffelman was welcome to come and haul away whatever concrete he required, but that the Village would not transport it for him.

Kneehill Regional
Water Services
Commission

Mayor Fegan advised Council that he attended a meeting of the Kneehill Regional Water Services Commission on April 29, 2004. At that time the engineers advised that geotechnical investigations had been completed for design purposes. All approvals had been obtained from Alberta Transportation with the exception of the Acme to Irricana portion of the line. The final Conservation and Reclamation Plan had been submitted. Eight (8) bids had been received for the reservoir supply line from Drumheller to the Kirkpatrick Reservoir. The ground-breaking ceremony at the reservoir has been scheduled for June 24, 2004. The pipeline construction from Drumheller to Acme should be completed by November 15, 2004. The Water Agreement with the Town of Drumheller is now in the final stages of completion.

Wild Rose Economic Development Corporation

Mayor Fegan advised Council that he attended a meeting of the Wild Rose Economic Development Corporation on May 6, 2004. WREDC is again offering their "I Want to be a Millionaire" program for children between the ages of 10 to 15 years of age. WREDC will also sponsor 4 participants between the ages of 13 – 15 years of age to attend the Alberta Youth Entrepreneurship Camp at Eagle's Nest Ranch in Cypress Hills, Alberta from August 22 - 28, 2004.

Mayor Fegan also advised Council that the WREDC is supportive of the Highway 21/Boomtown Trail Initiative. The WREDC is looking into a regional asset inventory project to create a business directory for the region.

#### ASSET (Assessment Shared Services Environment

#### ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT

The Administrator advised Council that for the tax year 2004, Alberta Municipal Affairs now requires that all assessment and property sales data be downloaded to Alberta Municipal Affairs through Milenet. In the past, this information would have been provided to Alberta Municipal Affairs in hard copy form from our assessor. From now on, this information must be submitted electronically through Milenet.

In order to be able to download this information, our software provider had to make a number of changes to the accounting software to comply with new requirements under ASSET. We then had to review each roll number and parcel of land to ensure that the proper liability codes had been assigned and that each parcel had the proper title number and line number. The Village of Beiseker has approximately 450 parcels of land on its tax roll.

The Administrator advised Council that she was happy to report that with the assistance of our assessor and office staff, that our assessment information was successfully downloaded through ASSET. Since we were able to do so before the deadline of May 17, 2004, we are eligible to receive a grant of \$1.00 per parcel of land with a minimum level of funding of \$500.00.

Hall Rental Rates & Utility Rate etc.

The Administrator advised Council that as a result of discussions at our recent budget meeting, that Council should pass a resolution to implement the increase in hall rental rates and utility rates effective June 1, 2004.
