A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF BEISEKER IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA  
BEING A BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE THE BEISEKER VILLAGE OFFICE AS A  
MUNICIPAL HISTORIC RESOURCE.

Whereas, Section 26 of the Historical Resources Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, c.H-9 as amended, permits council to designate any historic resource within the Village of Beiseker whose preservation Council considers to be in the public interest, together with any landing or on which it is located, as a Municipal Historic Resource;

And Whereas, the preservation of the Beiseker Village Office in the Village of Beiseker appears to be in the public interest;

And Whereas, the owners of the Beiseker Village Office have agreed to waive compensation now and in the future;

Now Therefore, THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEISEKER DULY ASSEMBLED HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

**"The Beiseker Village Office located at 700, 1st AVENUE in the Village of Beiseker is hereby designated as a municipal Historic Resource."**


1. This By-Law shall have effect from the date of the final passing thereof.
