

VILLAGE OF BEISEKER
BYLAW NO. 99-03

A Bylaw of the Village of Beiseker in the Province of Alberta for the purpose of closing to public travel and creating a separate title to a portion of a public highway in accordance with Section 22 of the Municipal Government Act, 1994, Chapter 26.1, Revised Statutes of Alberta, as amended

WHEREAS The lands herein described are no longer required for public travel nor will be required for public street purposes; and

WHEREAS application has been made to the Council to have the public street closed; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Beiseker deems it expedient to provide for a bylaw for the purpose of closing to public travel certain roads, or portions thereof, situated in the said municipality, and thereafter create title to same; and

WHEREAS notice of intention of the Council to pass a Bylaw has been given in accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act and

WHEREAS Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person prejudicially affected by the Bylaw;

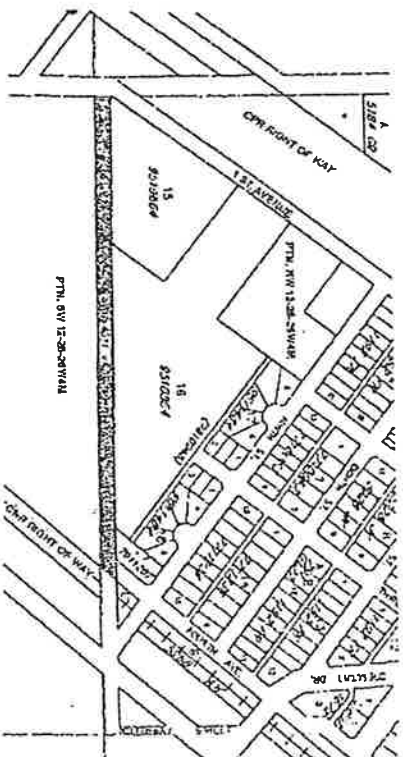
NOW THEREFORE be it resolved that the Council of the Village of Beiseker in the Province of Alberta does hereby close to public travel and create title to the following described roadway, subject to rights of access granted by other legislation:

Plan 4011 X.

That portion of the unnamed road in the NW ¼ 12-28-26-W4M which lies west of the production southwesterly of the northwest boundary of Block "C" on Plan 5968 A.W.

Excepting thereout all mines and minerals.

The portion of road to be closed is as generally illustrated on the following sketch.
