

**BYLAW NO. 2025-07**

**BEING A BYLAW TO AMEND THE WASTE MANAGEMENT AND RECYCLING BYLAW NO. 2025-04**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the provisions of *Municipal Government Act*, being Chapter M-26, RSA 2000, as amended, the power to pass a bylaw under this or any other enactments includes a power to amend or repeal the bylaw, and

**WHEREAS**, the amendment or repeal must be made in the same way as the original bylaw and is subject to the same consents or conditions or advertising requirements that apply to the passing of the original bylaw, unless this or any other enactment provides otherwise.

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of the Village of Beiseker, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw shall be cited as the Waste Management and Recycling Bylaw Amending Bylaw.
2. That Schedule “B” being the Permitted and Prohibited Materials – Material Collection and Disposal Schedule of the Waste Management and Recycling Bylaw No. 2025-04, is hereby amended by replacing the Waste Category section in its entirety with an updated Waste Category section as follows:
